Hi Jolly, BLM, Quartzsite: **Verizon**, 4G strong signal

Covered Wagon, Phoenix: **Verizon** 4G strong as the tower is visible

Eagle View RV park, Fort McDowell: **Verizon**, strong signal, 4G, able to stream, park has free strong Wi-Fi also

Apache Palms RV park, Tempe: **Verizon** 4G 3bar, may work for streaming but not high quality 1080

Roadrunner RV park, Lake Elsinore: **Verizon** weak 3G, no streaming

TTN Oakzanita Springs, Thousand Trails, Descanso: **Verizon** strong 4G, **AT&T** no signal

TTN Lake Minden, Thousand Trails, Nicolus: **Verizon** 4G, strong, stream quality

Win River Casino RV park, Redding: **Verizon** 4G, strong, stream quality

Trailer Village, Roswell: **Verizon** 4G strong, stream quality, this park also features it's own Wi-Fi that is very good

Bottomless Lakes State Park, Dexter: **Verizon** 4G strong, stream quality

Nevada

Beatty: free parking in middle of town, entrance to Death Valley, **Verizon** strong 4G, full bars

TTN Las Vegas: Thousand Trails, **Verizon** 3-bar 4G

Oregon

TTN Seaside, OR, Thousand Trails, Verizon strong 4-5 bar 4G signal throughout camp

Mt. Hood RV resort, Welches: **Verizon** strong 3-4 bar 4G signal throughout camp, poor Tengo Wi-Fi

Fort Stevens Oregon state park: **Verizon** spotty 3G, some 4G overall can use for streaming unless a storm rolls in, **Sprint** very sp

TTN Bend: Thousand Trails, **Verizon** strong 4-5 bar 4G signal throughout camp

TTN Pacific City: Thousand Trails, **Verizon no signal**

Haystack Reservoir, BLM, Culver: **Verizon** 4-5bar 4G signal, main camp far side of lake and skull hollow

Nehalem Bay: **Verizon** spotty 3G, good for internet not for streaming, **Sprint** spotty 3G good for internet not for streaming

Milo McIver State Park, Estacada: **Verizon** strong 4-5 bar 4G throughout park

Champoeg state park, St. Paul: **Verizon** strong 4-5 bar 4G throughout park

Lake Stimpert Marina and RV park, Madras: **Verizon no coverage**, but the park itself has great Wi-Fi

Lincoln City Devils Lake Oregon state park: **Verizon** weak 3G signal usable for internet, **Sprint** weak 3G signal usable for internet

Cove Palisades Oregon state park: **Verizon no coverage**, but the park does have Wi-Fi

Government Camp, Mt.Hood: **Verizon** strong 5 bar 4G signal

Shorewood Travel Trailer Village, Rockaway Beach: **Verizon** and **Sprint**, unreliable 3G, the park itself has great Wi-Fi

Brothers, Or. NFS, Rest area on the 395, **Verizon** 4G, fairly strong, 3 bars, but will stream

TTN Long Beach: Thousand Trails, **Verizon** 4G, stream quality

Umatilla Marina and RV park: **Verizon** 4G, strong, stream quality

TTN Circle M Thousand Trails, Lancaster: **Verizon**, 3g low signal, very weak, but with the Wilson Antenna, one bar short of full 4G

TTN Paradise Rv resort, Thousand Trails, Silver Creek: extremely strong **Verizon** 4G

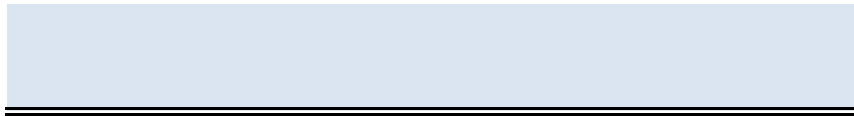
TTN Oceana, Thousand Trails, Ocean Shores: **Verizon** weak, unreliable 4G signal

Peter D's RV park, Sheridan: **Verizon** 2-3bar, streams but can be slow, park has Wi-Fi, can stream

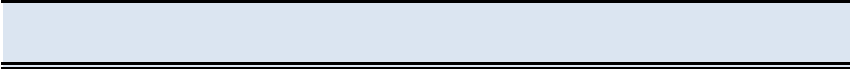
